Stallholder Requirements

- **Outdoor stallholders** must provide their own equipment, including marquees or large shade umbrellas, tables, chairs, and gazebo weights. Pegging into the ground is permitted.
- Outdoor stallholders may park **one vehicle directly behind their stall** on the field.
- **Indoor stallholders** must supply their own trestle tables unless prior arrangements have been made with Veronica (limited availability).
- Chairs inside the hall are available for use; however, they **must not be taken outside**. Please note that the hall also has long bench seating along each wall, which may be suitable for your setup (refer to hall images on the next page).

Parking

- After unloading, indoor stallholders are required to park along the **front perimeter line**, as indicated on the event map which will be released closer to event date.
- One **disabled parking space** will be reserved for patrons. If you require close vehicle access due to special circumstances, please speak with Veronica beforehand to arrange this.

Kitchen Facilities

- The hall kitchen area, including **two refrigerators**, is available for use by stallholders and event staff only.
- A microwave and sink are also available for shared use.

Bump In & Setup Times

- **Outdoor Stallholders:** Bump-in begins from **7:00 am Saturday morning**, unless early entry has been booked.
- **Indoor Stallholders:** Bump-in begins from **8:00 am Saturday morning**, unless early entry has been booked.

Early Entry (Friday Setup)

- Early entry allows stallholders to set up their space on **Friday from 1:00 pm onwards**.
- Please note there is **no professional security onsite**. Security will be limited to the event team, and the hall will be locked late Friday evening.
- **Do not leave money or high-value items overnight.**
- The additional early-entry fee applies to stallholders **camping overnight**. Indoor hall setup on Friday is otherwise free of charge.
- Please feel welcome to speak with Veronica directly if you would like further clarification.

Pack Down

- **Early pack-down is not permitted.**
- The event is expected to run until approximately **5:00 pm**, which will be official pack-down time.
- Vehicles will only be permitted onto the field **after 5:00 pm**.
- Stallholders are encouraged to bring **adequate lighting** for pack-down.

Waste Management

- All stallholders are responsible for removing any rubbish generated by their stall.

Payments & Connectivity

- Please bring a **cash float**, as mobile reception in Cedar Creek can be unreliable. Telstra coverage is generally strong, while Optus services may be inconsistent.

Weather & Event Changes

- In the case of severe or unsafe weather conditions, the event will be postponed to **Saturday, 1 August 2026**.
- If a Government-issued statewide lockdown occurs, the event will be rescheduled accordingly.

Refund Policy

- **No refunds** will be issued once a stallholder application has been processed.
- Stall spaces are **not confirmed until full payment is received**, unless a prior payment arrangement has been made with Veronica.
- Refunds will not be provided if a stallholder is unable to attend on the day.

Stallholder fees contribute toward event infrastructure, administration, marketing, advertising, and operational costs. This event is independently run by a small group of dedicated witchy enthusiasts and does not receive external funding or grants.

Vendor Selection

- The organiser reserves the right to decline unsuitable vendors or limit stalls offering similar products or services in order to maintain variety and balance across the event.

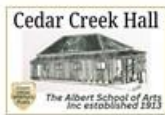

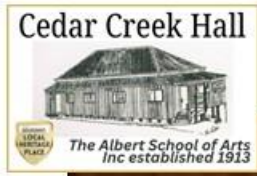

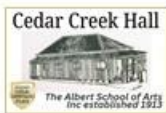
